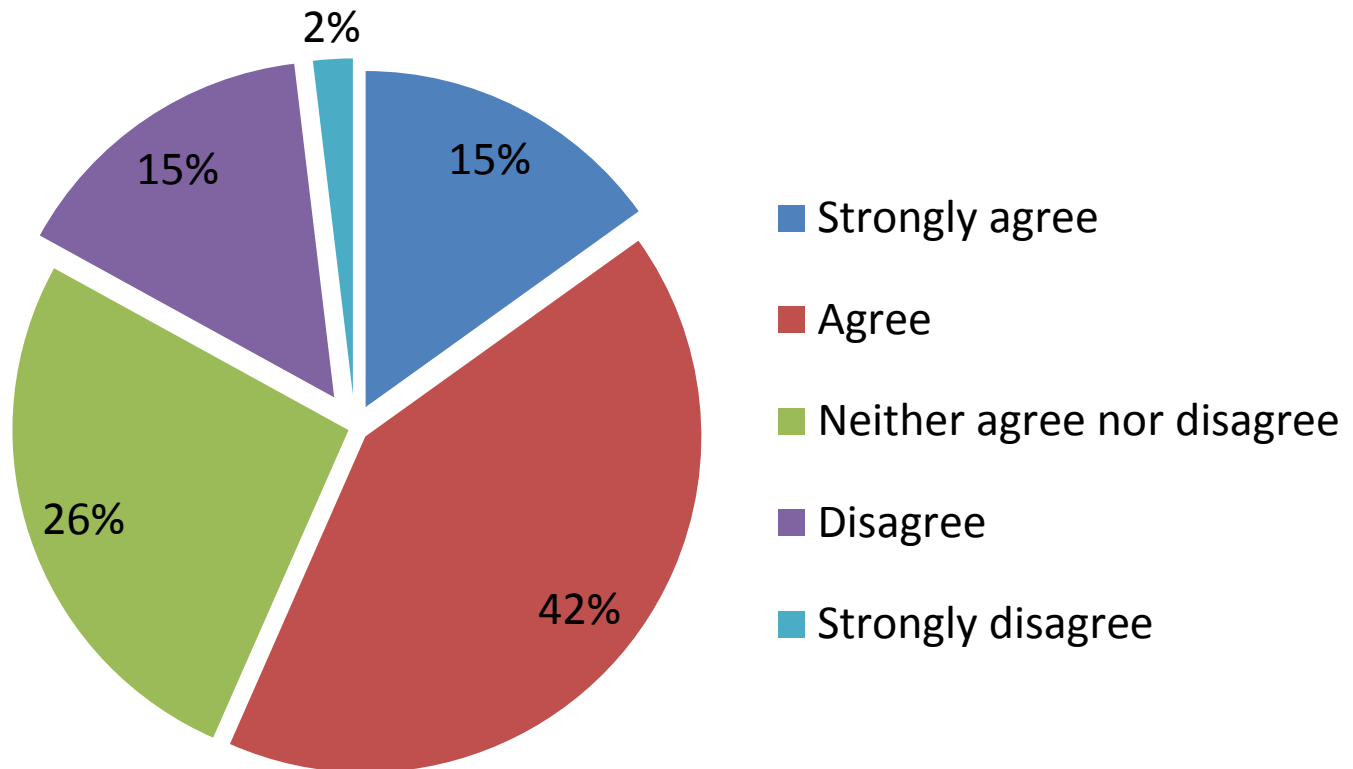

Do you agree or disagree that “Many CEOs or trustees of community foundations resist social justice philanthropy because they fear alienating donors”?



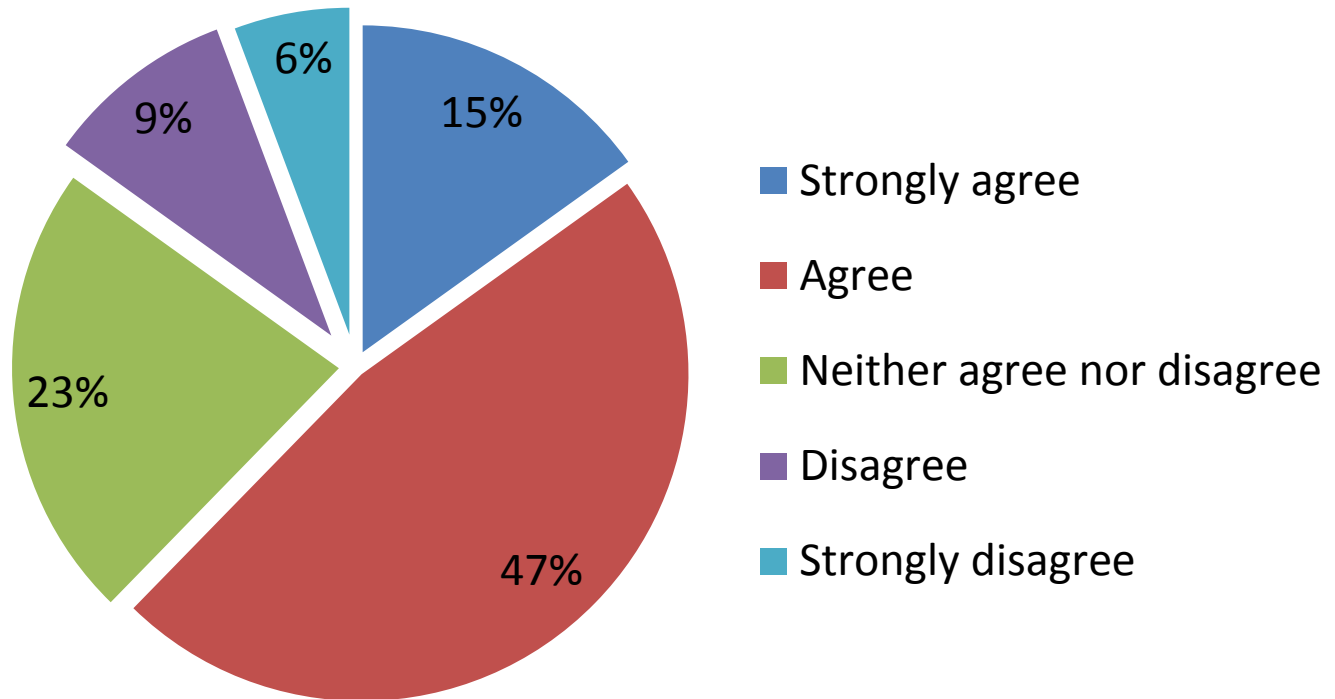
